

# **LEVITICUS, NUMBERS & DEUTERONOMY**

## **Syllabus**

### **I. GENERAL INFORMATION**

- A. This course consists of 13 video lessons.
- B. Each class is approximately 30 minutes long.
- C. Instructor: Russell Haffner.

### **II. DESCRIPTION AND PURPOSE**

- A. This course is an in-depth study of Leviticus, Numbers and Deuteronomy with emphasis on practical application, as well as on giving a working knowledge of the books, including background information.
- B. The lessons will help in understanding the relationship between the Old and New Testaments as well as how God's providence was at work in Old Testament times.

### **III. INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS**

- A. Bible.
- B. 13 video lessons.
- C. Course Notes.

### **IV. REQUIREMENTS**

- A. Read Leviticus, Numbers and Deuteronomy at least once.
- B. View each video lesson.
- C. Read the Course Notes. It is good to go through the notes at the same time you view the lessons, adding your own notes as needed.
- D. Submit a term paper (explained below).
- E. Take three exams.
- F. Have a grade average of 70 or more for each exam and a combined grade average of 70 or more for the course.

## V. EXAMS

- A. There are three comprehensive exams, one for each book.
- B. The study guides may be downloaded at any time. You may use the study guides while you are viewing the videos.
- C. When you take the exams you must do so completely from memory with no help from Bible, study guides, Course Notes, etc.
- D. You do not need a proctor when taking the exams. God is your witness.

## VI. TERM PAPER

- A. Write a paper **in your own words** explaining how the actions of Nadab and Abihu relate to our obedience today. In your paper you must refer to and explain the following verses: Leviticus 10:1-3.
- B. The paper should be two to three pages long (12 point font, **double** spaced). **Do not exceed four pages**. The paper should be approximately 600 to 900 words.
- C. The paper should be submitted after you take your final exam.

## VII. GRADING

- A. Term paper and exams will be graded separately.
- B. Final grade is based on an average of all assigned work.
- C. You may request that a grade be explained or reconsidered, but in any case the *WVBS Online Bible School* will have the final say.

## VIII. CREDIT

- A. Credit will be issued, including a certificate, only after all work has been successfully completed.
- B. We appreciate your study of God's inspired word through the *WVBS Online Bible School* and pray it helps you in your daily walk.
