EPHESIANS

Syllabus

I. GENERAL INFORMATION

- A. This course consists of 18 video lessons.
- B. Each class is approximately 30 minutes long.
- C. Instructor: Russell Haffner

II. DESCRIPTION AND PURPOSE

- A. This is an in-depth study of Ephesians with attention to doctrinal truths about the church and practical teaching for Christian living.
- B. Students will gain a greater knowledge of this book as well as what it teaches about Christ's church.
- C. To foster a heightened appreciation of the privilege of being added to the Lord's church and to exhort us all to live lives which befit the name we wear as Christians.

III. INSTRUCTIONAL MATERIALS

- A. Required:
 - 1. Bible,
 - 2. Eighteen video lessons and
 - 3. Course Notes.
- B. Optional:
 - 1. Any good (conservative) commentary on Ephesians.

IV. REQUIREMENTS

- A. Read the entire book of Ephesians at least three times.
- B. View all eighteen video lessons in their entirety.
- C. Read the Course Notes in their entirety.
- D. Submit a term paper (explained below).

- E. Take two exams.
- F. Have a grade average of 70 or more for each exam and a combined grade average of 70 or more for the course.

V. EXAMS

- A. There are two exams on Ephesians. The first covers chapters 1-3. The second covers chapters 4-6.
- B. The study guides may be downloaded at any time. You may use the study guides while you are viewing the videos.
- C. When you take an exam you must do so completely from memory with no help from your Bible, study guides, Course Notes, etc.
- D. You do not need a proctor when taking the exams, God is your witness.

VI. TERM PAPER

- A. Write a paper **in your own words** in which you give six (6) lessons to be learned from the book of Ephesians. Provide one lesson from **each** chapter. Develop each lesson into at least a full paragraph. Cite specific verse(s) in Ephesians on which you base each of the six (6) lessons.
- B. The paper should be two to three pages long (12 point font, **double** spaced). **Do not exceed four pages**. The paper should be approximately 600 to 900 words.
- C. The paper should be submitted after you take your final exam.

VII. GRADING

- A. Term paper and exams will be graded separately.
- B. Final grade is based on an average of all assigned work.
- C. You may request that a grade be explained or reconsidered, but in any case the WVBS Online Bible School will have the final say.

VIII. CREDIT

A. Credit will be issued, including a certificate, only after all work has been successfully completed.
