Syllabus

I. GENERAL INFORMATION.

- A. This course consists of 30 video lessons.
- B. Each class is approximately 38 minutes long.
- C. Instructor: Dr. Denny Petrillo.

II. DESCRIPTION AND PURPOSE.

- A. This is a detailed consideration of the inspired text of Job with special attention to the workings of God in the lives of men.

- F. It should spur us on to make necessary adjustments in our thinking and attitudes if they are contrary to God's will.

V. EXAM.

- C. When you take the exam you must do so completely from memory with no help from your Bible, Course Notes, etc.
- D. You do not need a proctor when taking the exam. God is your witness.

VII. TERM PAPER.

A. Write a paper in your own words on the life of Job - from prosperity to misery and back to prosperity again. At the end enumerate at least **three** (3) lessons for us today.

- B. The paper should be two to three pages long (12 point font, **double** spaced). **Do not exceed four pages**. The paper should be approximately 600 to 900 words.
- C. The paper should be submitted after you take your final exam.

VIII. GRADING.

- A. Term paper and exam will be graded separately.
- B. Final grade is based on an average of all assigned work.
- C. You may request a grade be explained or reconsidered, but in any case the WVBS Online Bible School will have the final say.

IX. CREDIT.

- A. Credit will be issued, including a certificate, only after all work has been successfully completed.
